



ONTARIO'S WILDLIFE DAMAGE COMPENSATION PROGRAM

“What to do if Your Livestock or Poultry has been Killed by Wildlife”

- 1) Notify the Township Office (613-432-2885) of the livestock/poultry loss and we will notify the valuer. If the kill happens on the weekend it is permitted to call the livestock valuer directly but the township office must be notified the next business day to report the loss also.
- 2) **DO NOT REMOVE THE CARCASS FROM THE KILL SITE** – as the valuer has to examine the area for evidence to help determine the cause of the loss. Please note – The combined weight of poultry killed must be 25 kilograms for a claim to be completed).

Secure kill site from disturbance:

- Avoid walking in or around the area
- Place a tarp over the carcass
- Take photos of the scene if possible for review and use by the livestock valuer

To be Eligible for Compensation an Applicant **must** also:

- ❖ Provide a valid (current) **Farm Business Registration number (FBR)** issued by Ministry (1-866-327-3678 or fbr@agricorp.com renewable each year)
- ❖ Provide a **Premises identification** number (free registration at 1-855-697-7743 (does not have to be renewed each year))
- ❖ Provide their **Social Insurance or Business Registration Number** as the municipality will issue an ARG-1 form at year end for inclusion in the income tax return.
- ❖ Demonstrate to the Valuer reasonable effort has been taken to prevent incidences of wild life damage to livestock or poultry.
