**A By-Law to Amend By-Law No. 2010-50
Establishing Requirements For Open Air Burning
In The Township of Admaston/Bromley**

WHEREAS on September 16, 2010 the Corporation of the Township of Admaston/Bromley enacted By-Law No. 2010-50 for establishing requirements for Open Air Burning in the Township of Admaston/Bromley;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to amend the said By-Law by deleting in its entirety Section 7.3 of By-Law No. 2010-50 and amending Annex "B" being the Schedule of Fees.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Admaston/Bromley enacts as follows:

1. That By-Law No. 2010-50 is hereby amended by deleting Section 7.3 and amending Item 3 in the attached Annex "B".
2. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect upon the passing thereof.

ANNEX "B" TO BY-LAW NO. 2012-48

Schedule of Fees

- 1, Respond to and investigate complaint in regards to a possible violation under Section 2.0 about open air burning
 - a. Fee of \$75.00 per response payable by the permit holder or person setting, maintaining or allowing such fire to be lit if the complaint is substantiated
 - b. Fee of \$75.00 per response payable by the complainant if the complaint is not substantiated
 - (i) Fee may be waived at the discretion of the investigator if in their opinion the complaint was reasonable and made in good faith but investigation showed no violation under any section of this bylaw had occurred.
2. Dispatch of Fire-fighters.
 - a. (to be calculated at current rate of pay per fireman responding to the scene at one (1) hour minimum per fireman and calculated on one half hour increments thereafter).
3. Dispatch of Fire Response vehicles actively involved in fighting the fire.
 - a. **(to be calculated at the current M.T.O. rates)**
