

What is **NOT** recyclable in our Blue Box Program

Car tires, car parts, dirty flower pots and/or no recycle symbol, pots and pans, “real” zippered plastic bags (usually for blankets or bed-in-bag sets), solar blankets, fiberglass feed bags, all styrofoam packaging, bubble wrap, sponge foam, foam sheeting, small or large appliances, hard cover books, plastic or metal strapping, picture frames, plastic with metal paint pails, hangers, oil containers, compost, glass or ceramic dishes, Tupperware, Rubbermaid, plastic toys, window pane glass, wood, diapers, electronics of any sort.
