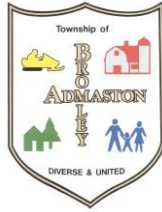


Township of Admaston/Bromley

The Township of Admaston/Bromley is continuing to monitor the public health challenges presented by COVID-19. While no cases have been identified to date in Renfrew County we continue to engage with partners and stakeholders in the health community.

The Township is maintaining essential services as we continue to monitor the situation with guidance from the Public Health Unit and other levels of government. As of 4:30pm, Wednesday March 18, 2020, the Municipal Office will be closed to the public until further notice. Services such as road maintenance and landfill sites will remain the same. Tax payments are still able to be made online, at the bank or can be deposited in the mailbox at the office. Meetings with township staff can be made on a case-by-case basis.
