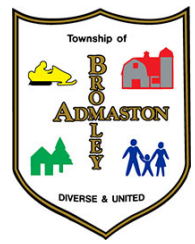

Check to see if you are on the Voters' List by contacting your local Municipality.

You are an eligible voter in the 2022 Municipal Election on October 24th, 2022 if you:

- Are a Canadian citizen;
- Are 18 years of age or older;
- Reside in the Township or are the owner or tenant of land thereof, or the spouse of such owner or tenant;
- Are not prohibited from voting by law.

Eligible electors can only vote once!
