BY-LAW NO. 2012-19

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE A REDUCED LOAD PERIOD ON THE TOWNSHIP OF ADMASTON/BROMLEY ROADS

WHEREAS Section 122 (7) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, provides that the Municipal Corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway, may by By-Law, designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end, and the highway or portion thereof, under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

AND WHEREAS the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways, under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Township of Admaston/Bromley.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Admaston/Bromley enacts as follows:

- 1. The provisions of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act, apply to various highways under the jurisdiction of the Township of Admaston/Bromley, during the period from the first day of March to the thirty-first day of May inclusive, in each and every year. A schedule shall be made available for all restricted Township Roads annually.
- 2. The provisions of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act shall also apply to various roads under the jurisdiction of the Township of Admaston/Bromley at such times as may be deemed necessary by the Road Superintendent.
- 3. This By-Law shall not become effective until appropriate signage has been erected, in a conspicuous place.
- 4. By-Law No. 2005-10 is hereby repealed.
