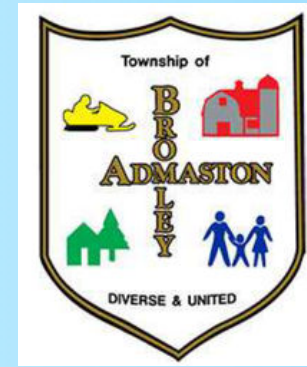


Welcome to the Admaston Bromley Barn Quilt Trail.

Many of the Barn Quilts in Admaston Bromley Township were created in 2019 when resident Brenda Dwyer took the initiative to have the long weekend in May dedicated to making traditional 8' x 8' wooden barn quilts with a group of 20+ participants from all over the south end of Renfrew County. The BQ bee started on Friday and went all day, every day until Monday evening. Once completed, they got mounted on barns and sheds. Some of those participants continued to make more BQ for themselves, family, friends or for sale.



Admaston Bromley Township is a beautiful rural area made up mostly of farmland, forests and many small lakes, including the Bonnechere River running through the middle. It ranges from Mount St. Patrick to Renfrew, following parallel to Hwy 17 near Haley Station and Cobden, up to almost Micksburg. This township includes Douglas and Osceola with major roads being Hwy 132, Hwy 60, County Rd 5, and County Rd 8. Within the township are 1 high school, 2 elementary schools, 4 churches and many recreational opportunities.
